We are excited to announce that Signal Behavioral Health Network is funding CAC coursework through Seven Cedars for people who live or work in Arapahoe County.

Funds are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis only to people who want to become credentialed addiction counselors. Participation in this training program is a serious undertaking and our requirements for participation are rigorous. Classes are not self-directed prospective students must be willing to dedicate at least an hour a day for online courses and take full days off for live classes (our classes are live via Zoom). Students must also be detail-oriented, able to follow instructions, and computer-literate. If you are willing to put a great deal of effort into a rewarding and meaningful career, this is your first step.

Signal will pay tuition for CAC Technician, CAC Specialist, and Licensed Addiction Counselor courses. Students will pay for a CERTS ID#, Colorado Jurisprudence Exam, NAADAC national exam fees, schedule changes, and any courses missed or not passed.

Funds cannot reimburse for enrollments already registered, these are for new enrollments only. Qualifying students will sign an agreement with Seven Cedars listing expectations and requirements for participation in courses. If you received grant funding previously you must be a student in good standing – in other words, you completed your funded classes as agreed or reimbursed us for any classes you missed or did not pass.
